Affiliation donations for the year Sept 10 to Aug 11 have been received from: Sudbury Baptist, Christ Church URC, St Gregorys, Cornard C.F., Stour Valley Vineyard, Springlands C.F., Lavenham PCC, Catholic Church, H.T. L.Melford & Salvation Army.

Current suggested donations are: small organisations £60 (£23 for general funds & £37 for n:vision rent) and £85 for larger (£33 g.f. & £52 n:vision)- these are again due for the new year (2010/11) , if your church/fellowship is not listed above please could you remind your Treasurer! Thank you.

General Fund. £200.81 was given at the Forum for the S.Army work in Haiti and £250 was sent to the Salvation Army, who have expressed their thanks – the balance of £49.19 coming out of Kettle & Fish. £110.25 has been paid to Ecclesiastical Insurance for the P.L. premium, £15 to the Rotary Club for the Christmas Tree event and £75 for Lent booklets.

Kettle & Fish at St Peters. The net refreshment etc sales income averaged £233.04 for 10 openings (highest £324.50, lowest £135.80), plus £90 on Cycle Ride day. Paid £395 to Ministry of Music for the Eden's concert on 1<sup>st</sup> October, £59.73 for office supplies, £54.29 for catering supplies, £225.04 to Primo Coffee & Tea, £38.96 to St Andrews Bookshop for books sold & £40.50 for Gospels & Why Jesus/Christmas? booklets, £26.81 for 75 Christian Calendars, £46.80 to St Johns Traidcraft for sugar, coffee & tea, £64.81 for 'Thank you' lunch food, £30 for use of All Saints Hall, £400 to Friends of St Peters for rent and £1000 for the refurbished heating system and £250 to Eden's Project to make up for the low offering at the October United Service.

Healing group. £260 was given by participants on course. £77.76 was paid for course books, £104 for the use of the Quaker hall for 8 sessions and a £25 Book Token for Rev Martin Thrower. £81 had been paid out for books in the previous year, leaving K&F to pay £27.76.

Future Vision. £189 has been paid to Woodhall School for 14 evenings in the current term.

Eden's Project. The offering at the October United Service amounted to £185.36 - £390.37 in 2007, £231.96 in 2008 and £217.43 in 2009. They have expressed their thanks.

Dorcas fund 'for doing good and helping the poor'. K&F are proposing that 10% of each of their bankings should go to this fund, and I propose to send a letter to those who can use it – Clergy, etc.

Men in Christ- Sudbury. £34 has been received from MiC-S and £37.50 was paid for a Pizza evening and £13 to the Quakers for the use of their hall.
