### General Fund.

Kettle & Fish at St Peters. The net refreshment etc sales income on 6<sup>th</sup> Dec. (Friday Lights evening) £32.48, on 16<sup>th</sup> Dec. £158.47, Christmas Festival £310.60, 6<sup>th</sup> January £205.81 & 13<sup>th</sup> Jan £202.07; £20.58 & £20.20 respective to the latter 2 dates being credited to the Dorcas Fund. £87.61 was paid for catering supplies, £56.26 to Primo Coffee & Tea Co, £14.90 to St Johns Traidcraft for tea bags & sugar, £150 to Friends of St Peters for rent, £14.16 for 24 mugs, £46.53 for 8 new table cloths, £37.40 to Sudbury Office Supplies for 4 printer cartridges & £51.82 to St Andrews Bookshop for books sold.

Healing group. A further £30 was received from participants on course, thereby turning the deficit of £27.76 into a credit of £2.24.

Future Vision. £81 paid to Woodhall School for 6 n:vision evenings in the current half-term. £67.50 due for 5 evenings for second half-term. The united service offering totalled £326.88 which has been passed on to Future Vision, for which they have expressed their thanks.
