### What does the church have to offer us?

Both churches are in gloriously isolated positions. Shimpling seats around 200 people, Alpheton around 70, the latter still with a grass path to the picturesque porch and oil lamps for lighting inside. Both have small pipe organs. Shimpling has easy disabled access, Alpheton has steps down into the church but a portable ramp is available.

# How much will it cost to get married there?

Around £600 at either church.

## What else can the church provide for the couple?

Floral arrangements of a high standard can be provided but the couple would be expected to fund these.

#### What are the requirements or expectations for couples?

Anyone who lives within the parishes of Long Melford, Alpheton or Shimpling or who has strong family connections with these parishes can chose to marry at any of these parish churches.
