At Bridge Street, take the first turning off to your left, follow road, left again into Aveley Lane, continue along Aveley Lane for about 2 miles until you come to some houses and the road bends. Look out for wooden sign on post, on this bend pointing to 'the Church' to the left (post is on one's right). The church is off Aveley Lane, approached via an avenue of lime trees opposite Old Rectory Lane, Shimpling IP29 4HF. Parking is available in the field to the left of the avenue leading to the church.*
