General Fund. £20 rent was paid for the March Forum at Woodhall School. The Christian Aid United Service offering was £206.88 and has been passed on to Christian Aid. The total to date for the town is £4817.16.

Kettle & Fish at St Peters. The net refreshment etc sales income was £3011.46 from 12 openings – of this a total of £301.13 was transferred to the Dorcas Fund. £23.59 was paid for Fairtrade bunting, £127.13 was paid for catering supplies, £112.52 to Primo Coffee & Tea Co, £225.00 for logoed Tablecloths, £14.95 to St Johns Traidcraft, £95.05 to St Andrews Bookshop for books sold, £24.98 for stationery items, £29.49 for a laminator & £450 was paid to Friends of St Peters.

Future Vision. £135 rent paid to Woodhall School for the current term.

Dorcas fund ‘for doing good and helping the poor’. £95 has been given as part of the tenancy deposit for a young man who is making his first home.

Prayer Breakfasts. £152.21 was received from PBs and at their request £100 was given to Neil Holmes and £50 to Future Vision for children’s Easter magazines.

Men in Christ-Sudbury. £270 was received from their Men Unleashed day, and £489.79 was paid on their behalf to Christian Vision for Men for their input for the day.

Events. The net cost of the Jenny Rees Larcombe visit was £408.77.
The cost of I-Spy Easter was £334.72, including £41.35 for Easter eggs, £80 for the hire of costumes & £50 to the Friends of St Peters.
