What does the church have to offer us?

Holy Trinity Church is world renowned for its stunning architecture, its setting and stained glass. It is one of only 18 five-star churches in the country and as a result is a centre for tourism. There is a magnificent organ and choir of both men and women.

How much will it cost to get married there?

Around £1,100 which includes the professional organist, experienced choir, bell-ringers and basic flowers (three pedestals). This figure can be reduced considerably if the choir and bells are not required.

What else can the church provide for the couple?

Floral arrangements of a high standard can be provided but the couple would be expected to fund these. Alternatively couples are welcome to bring in their own florist or supply flowers for the church arrangers to use.

What are the requirements or expectations for couples?

Anyone who lives within the parishes of Long Melford, Alpheton or Shimpling or who has strong family connections with these parishes can choose to marry at any of these parish churches. Those outside these parishes are still welcome to apply as there may be circumstances where the marriage can take place legally. Please use contact above for further details.
