The two Rotary Clubs of Sudbury have great pleasure in announcing the launch of the twelfth Sudbury Christmas Tree Festival and in inviting you to take part in this very popular event in St Peter's Church.

The Festival will take place between Wednesday 10 December and Sunday 14 December.

The trees will be delivered to St Peter's on Tuesday 9 December and are to be decorated in the afternoon; decorating to be completed by 4pm on that day. The formal opening of the Festival will take place that evening.

As you know, this event attracts large numbers of visitors not only from Sudbury itself but also from much further afield. It provides therefore a wonderful showcase for your organisation, charity, business, school, church. Places in St Peter's are greatly sought after and we recommend that you apply as soon as possible for a tree. The cost per tree is £16, which includes electricity.

Conditions of participation

No fund-raising is permitted. As this is an event run by the two Sudbury Rotary Clubs, all proceeds will go to the Clubs for distribution to local charities.

Because of health and safety concerns, no gifts or giveaways are permitted.

Leaflets or business cards may be placed tidily near your tree.

Please note that only low-voltage lighting is allowed.

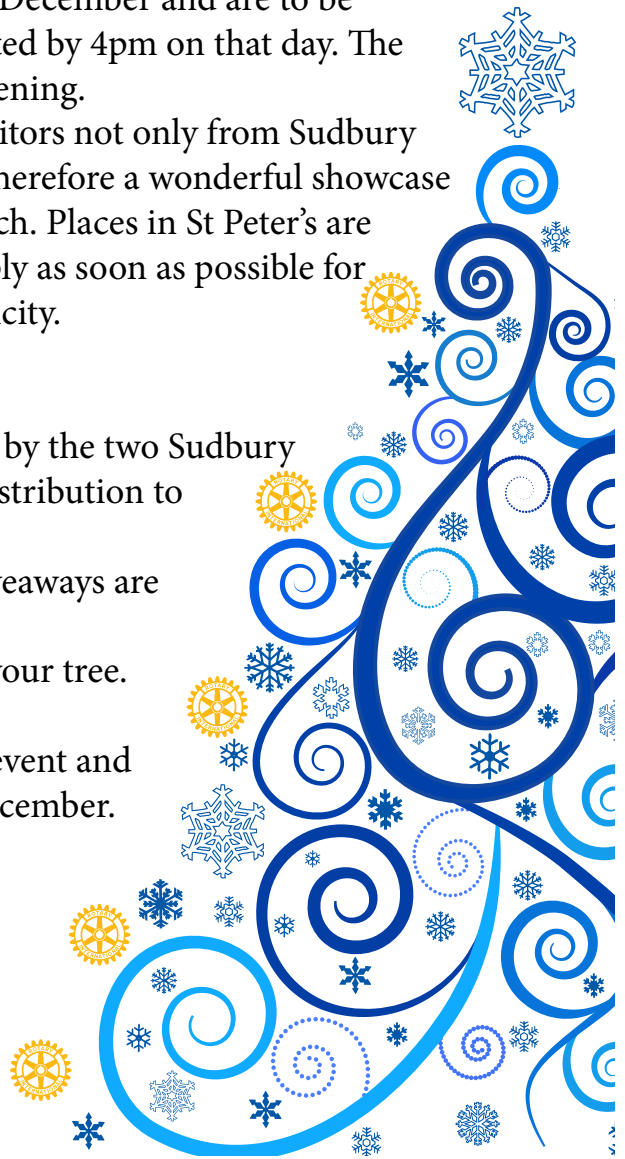
The Christmas tree remains your property after the event and must be removed from the Church on Sunday 14 December.
