Kettle & Fish. The total refreshment sales bankings were £2479.30 (7 openings) - of this £247.94 was transferred to the Dorcas Fund. £801.17 was paid for catering goods, £10.25 to St Johns Traidcraft for teabags, £130.70 to Primo Coffee & Tea Ltd, £119.99 for a fridge, £42 for 2 Christmas meals & £300 to Friends of St Peters.

Dorcas Fund. £240 given to support the Sudbury Community Depot & £70.95 paid for one nights B&B for a homeless man.

Future Vision. The second quarterly £500 was paid to them on 12th January & the third on 3rd April; fourth due in July. The January United Service cash offering was £182.44 plus a £20 CAF cheque and these has been passed on to FV.
