General Fund. The offering for Christian Aid at the United Service at St Andrews, Great Cornard, was £126.96 and this has been passed on to Sudbury Christian Aid group and £75 was given to Victor Jack as travelling expenses and a gift for speaking at Pentecost Praise.

Kettle & Fish. The total refreshment sales bankings were £2224.31 (6 openings) - of this £222.44 was transferred to the Dorcas Fund. £728.89 was paid for catering goods, £16.00 to St Johns Tradecraft for sugar sticks, £450 to Friends of St Peters for hire plus £50 towards moving the water heater to a safer height & £19.99 for a replacement highchair.

Dorcas Fund. £36.98 was paid for a new pair of shoes for a man with various difficulties & £100 to Abi's Footsteps.

Future Vision. The 4<sup>th</sup> quarterly payment of £500 is due to them in July.

Prayer Breakfasts. £167.02 was received from Prayer Breakfasts on 25<sup>th</sup> April.

Eden's Project. I believe that Edens is in need of around £5000 to complete the purchase of 45 Gainsborough Street and all the associated legal and maintenance work.

Marriage Focus Group. No transactions in current year.

Samuel Dequemin. Thanks have been received from Westminster Theological Centre for the £1000 contribution towards Sam's fees this year – he is just about to complete the course.
